

Co-Curricular Clubs & Societies

Co-curricular Clubs & Societies are an integral part of the day to day life of a student at Wallington County Grammar School. Participation and engagement in clubs and societies is something that runs through a student's entire school life at WCGS. The curriculum outside the classroom playing a vital part in a students development from when they join in year 7 to when they leave in Upper Sixth.

Our school day structure allows for a dedicated clubs and societies period, twice a week for most year groups and more for senior students. Staff and students run clubs that aim to broaden the opportunities for students to engage in something outside of their studies. This may be an academic club such as Physics or Maths society, aimed at going beyond the subject curriculum. Other clubs include Debating society, Chess club, both of which allow students to engage in national competitions, or simply students may choose to do something they really enjoy in Robotics club or Star Wars Society.

Early in each academic year the School holds a 'Clubs & Societies Fair' which proves hugely popular with all students and where students can sign up to attend a particular club or society that they may be interested in.
